My dear Confreres,

Cordial greetings from Vinayalaya, Bangalore. We are in the month of September and we have two important days in this month (September 15th and September 30th) that need our personal attention and community celebration. The feast of Mother of Compassion and Mermier's Day fall on this month reminding us of our need to show our filial love toward our Patroness and our deep love for our Founder and our Congregation.



Let me share with you a thought that Our Holy Father Benedict XVI shared with the people at CASTEL GANDOLFO, reflecting on the gospel of Mathew 16: 21 - 26. When Jesus prophesied his suffering, death, and resurrection, Peter rebelled and said to his Master: "God forbid, Lord! This shall never happen to you". What appears evident here is the plan of God

for his only begotten Son on the cross to save humanity, and the expectations, desires, and the

plans of the disciple. There is a discord between the plan of God and the plans of disciples. The same discord occurs also today. When the fulfillment of one's life is directed solely to social success, to physical and economic wellbeing, then one no longer reasons according to God, but according to worldly standards. To think according to the world is to put God aside, not to accept his plan of love, almost impeding the fulfillment of his holy will. Benedict XVI invited Christians to follow Christ by accepting the cross with love, though in the

eyes of the world, this seems a defeat and loss of life.



1. September 15, Feast of Mother of Compassion

The feast of Mother of Sorrows and Founder's Day invite us all to seek the plan of God like Mary our Mother and Father Peter Mermier, our Founder. "Where there is less of our own choice there is more of God" was the test given by St. Francis de Sales in seeking the will of God.

We have a special devotion to the Virgin Mother of God, who being closely related to the Mystery of Christ, is the model for our consecrated and apostolic life. We express our filial love to Mary by meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, the Seven Sorrows and by honoring her as the Mother of Compassion (Const. 109).

The solemnities of St. Francis de Sales and of the Mother of Compassion are to be celebrated by all with earnestness and love. The feast day celebrations must be preceded by appropriate preparatory devotional practices like Novena etc. (Gen. Dir. 80/iii).

It is recommended that as a devotional practice all perpetually professed members make a devotional renewal of their vow once a year on a day fixed by the Provincial to deepen their awareness that the final commitment is an on-going one (Gen. Dir. 80/ii).

Please make sure that we start the novena to the Mother of Compassion by September 6th. All the perpetually professed confreres can come together some time on or around the Feast Day or Founder's Day for a devotional renewal of vows as recommended by our General Directory. The Local Superiors, Conveners of Apostolic Communities, and the Rectors of Formation Houses can coordinate this devotional practice according to your discretion in consultation with community members.

2. September 30, Founder's day

A preparation lasting nine days is to be made in order to highlight the solemnity of the Founder's Day on 30^{th} September every year. Our deep love for our Founder and our Congregation should mark these days. A votive Mass in honor of St. Francis de Sales is to be celebrated on the Founder's Day (Gen. Dir. 80/ IV).

I recommend a celebration of Founder's Day at the Apostolic Community or Local Community level.

3. Provincial's Visitation

Please accept my profound gratitude for extending warm hospitality and generosity during my visit with you personally, and at Local community level/Apostolic Community level. I had the opportunity to be part of the Apostolic Community meetings in some units. It was also an opportunity for me to see personally the various ministries in our Province. Each situation and each ministry is unique. Along with the challenges and struggles our confreres encounter in some places, there is also reward and fulfillment. I appreciate the way you deal with various situations with commitment, optimism, and missionary spirit. We need short term and long term planning to address our concerns. We need to strike a balance between stabilization and expansion of our projects. Effectiveness lies in the balance. Each center has to evolve its mission and vision plan

that is realistic and realizable within the limited financial and human resources available in the Province. We need to apply our heart and mind to work out the best options for each center of the Province.

4. Provincial Chapter 2011

We have begun our preparations for the Provincial Chapter. The Reflection Paper on "Re-Discovering our MSFS Identity: A Prophetic Response to Emerging Threats to our Religious Life and Missionary Life" is sent to all our confreres. If you have not received a copy yet, please let the secretary know. The prayer in preparation for the Chapter is to be recited by all as spiritual preparation. The Conveners of Apostolic Communities, Delegates to the Provincial Chapter, and Representatives of the Scholastics will make an effort to facilitate the process of sharing and preparing a comprehensive report on the Reflection Paper based on the questions. Your active participation and contribution mean a lot. The Report from each Apostolic Community or geographical unit should reach the Provincial's office on or before September 20, 2011.
