Rev. Fr. Onayathumkuzhy Zacharias

Rev. Fr. Onayathumkuzhy Zacharias was born on 20th May 1926 in Velichiyani, Kerala to Mr. Varghese and Mrs. Elizabeth. Having desired to become a missionary and to proclaim the Word of God he joined St. Joseph's Mission Home in 1947 after which he did his philosophy and Theology in Sacred Heart Seminary Poonamlee. In Margao, Goa he had his novitiate and made his First Religious Profession on 27th May 1953 and was ordained a priest on 27th April 1957. As a new priest he worked in Kothavalsa, Vepada and S. Kota in the then diocese

of Visakhapatnam. He was also a philosophy professor of the Fathimagiri Seminary which we had started in Nilambur and continued for four years. Later he was Master of Novices at Salesianum, Visakhapatnam for 6 years. He also worked in LRG School Anantapur, Dornala for 3 years, in the Regional Philosophate of Andhra Pradesh in Kondadaba (3 years) and as Professor of Philosophy at Suvidya College, Bangalore. He was Rector of Vinayalaya from 1990-1993, Superior of Mermier Bhavan community from 1993-1999. He also served as the parish priest of Yelahanka for 3 years. At present he is the spiritual director in S.F.S. Minor Seminary, Ettumanoor and is the Director of Charis Marian Maids from 2005. Right from the Minor Seminary to the end of Theology Fr. Zacharias has accompanied various batches of students, who are priests today. They have drawn inspiration from him as a person who keeps deep intimacy with the Lord, a person who is gentle, kind, simple and affable. *Ad Multos Annos*

Rev. Fr. Thudianplackal Mathew

Rev. Fr. Thudianplackal Mathew was born on 14th July 1929 in Alanadu, Palai, Kerala to Mr. Mathew and Mrs. Anna. After finishing his school studies he joined the seminary in 1948. He did his philosophical studies in Sacred Heart Seminary, Poonamallee after which he was sent to Margao, Goa for the canonical year of Novitiate where he made his First Religious Profession on 15th May 1954. Then he came to Papal Seminary, Poona for his Theology and was ordained on 26th May 1957. During the initial years of Priesthood he worked as a missionary in Salur and Parvathipuram in the diocese of Visakhapatnam. A born mechanic and builder he did enormous service in this field during the rest of his life. For a year he supervised and built the St. John's Regional Seminary Hyderabad. Then he was engaged in the repair of St. Ann's Cathedral, Visakhapatnam. Along with European Fathers he worked for 10 years in St. Aloysius' Industrial School Visakhapatnam, training young boys from the remote villages and making them capacitated to get a job in the growing industrial city of Visakhapatnam. Later he was appointed manager of St. Aloysius' Industrial School. He constructed one wing of S.F.S. Minor Seminary Ettumanoor, the boarding of L.R.G. School, Anantapur and the school and Church in Shantinagar, Hyderabad. In 1980 he came to Bangalore and from 1981 to 1991 he was the parish priest of Holy Rosary Church Venkatala. He continued his stay there and worked as Chaplain to the Missionaries of Charity, helping them in their ministry to the mentally and physically challenged people. At present he is chaplain to Catherine Nivas, Vidyanagar, Bangalore. Fr. Mathew is affable, loving, caring and never makes a show of the innumerable services he renders. *Ad Multos Annos*

Rev. Fr. Antony Mookenthottam

Rev. Fr. Antony Mookenthottam was born on 28th February 1931 in Narianganam, Palai, Kerala to Mr. Thomman and Mrs. Mary. He joined St. Joseph's Mission Home, Kanjikuzhy, Kottayam in June 1949. He studied Philosophy and Theology in Sacred Heart Seminary Poonamallee. He did his novitiate in Margao, Goa and made his First Religious profession on 27th May 1953 and his final profession was on 27th May 1956 at Visakhapatnam. He was ordained a priest at Poonamalle seminary on 27th April 1957. Fr. Antony was associated with the diocese of Visakhapatnam in the beginning of his ministry and worked in Salur and Gnanapuram. He was elected as the Municipal Councilor of Visakhapatnam from 1959-63 as he was Parish Priest of Gnanapuram. He also rendered his service in the field of education. He was correspondent of St. Antony's High School (1964-1965), Maharanipetta. He was deeply committed to the work of the Congregation and served it in various capacities. He was

General Councilor (1965-'74) and did his Doctorate (1978) in Fribourg University. Then he worked in the research department in Ishwani Kendra, Pune (1979-'80). Later he moved to Bangalore as he was appointed the rector of Vinayalaya (1980-'82). In 1982 he was elected as Provincial (1982-'85). A well-known professor and scholar of Theology, philosophy and spirituality he has to his credit a number of books. He joined the staff of Suvidya College in 1989. He was parish priest in Hebbagodi from 1992-'95. Fr. Antony also got involved in the prison ministry as he was the parish priest of Hebbagoi and continued even when he had teaching commitment in Suvidya College. He is one of the pioneers of our Congregation in developing Salesian Spirituality and he translated *Introduction to the Devout Life* and some other works. His age and illness never discouraged him from taking up any responsibility. In 1999 he joined the team which pioneered Chad mission, the most challenging mission of the Congregation. He was also part of the administration of South-west Province in two terms (1997-2000) and (2003-'06). He served as director in the Indian Institute of Spirituality from 2003-2005. He is known for his commitment and availability and he never turns down any request from the confreres. *Ad Multos Annos*

Hearty Congrats Fr. Santhosh Kumar

Fr. Santhosh Kumar is back from Rome after completing his Ph.D. in the Pontifical Urbanian University. His performance has been valued as "Summa cum Laude" that is 29/30. He defended his thesis on 17.11.2006 on the theme "Universal Presuppositions of Communication and Discourse Ethics of Juergen Habermas". His scientific commitment was unanimously judged worthy of praise by the Faculty and he is highly recommended for research and teaching. In the name of the Province I offer him our heartfelt congratulations.

Synopsis of his thesis

Through a program of universal pragmatics Habermas seeks to expose universal pragmatic features of language. His contention is that pragmatic features of utterances could be rationally reconstructed in universal terms. In as much as language has a universal core so also speech or communicative competence has a universal core. Therefore, Habermas seeks to unpack the universal presuppositions involved in using language in order to achieve an understanding.

Habermas applies the results of this program to discourse ethics. He seeks to ground his discourse ethics in the fundamental presuppositions of argumentation. Discourse involves the give and take of reasons for holding or rejecting certain validity claims. It basically involves argumentation and this argumentation should lead to universally valid claims and it should, in particular, provide a forum to arrive at universal norms. In short, from the universal core of communicative competence to the universal core of morality, is what Habermas is trying to propose and this is what is explored and explicated in this thesis.

Fr. K.V. Joseph left for Papua New Guinea on 6th December 2006. The mission of PNG is entrusted to the care of Visakhapatnam province. After his term as Novice Master Fr. K.V. Blessing of Nest and Three Years of FidesIndia
