My dear Confreres,

The season of Lent is slowly coming to its culmination as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the mysteries of the Easter Triduum. The Holy Week is a week of contrasts and paradoxes, and it is precisely in them that the grace and beauty of the Holy Week are to be found. Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem ends with betrayal and crucifixion; he arrives riding on a colt; ends by being dragged across the streets and made to carry a cross. He is welcomed by the crowd by throwing their cloaks on the ground and given the sent off by throwing insults at him; His being acclaimed as a king ends with shouts of **"Crucify him."** The worst in all these is not just the anonymous crowd, but even the disciples go from joining him in this triumphant procession into Jerusalem to arguing among themselves as to who is greatest among them, to denying any kind of knowledge about him, and finally to betraying him. Yet, it is in the midst of such contradictions, that we hear Jesus' words in John: **"It's accomplished."** Herein lies a clear message of Easter: Not only that redemption is won bitterly, from hard, unyielding things -- that Christ wrestles salvation from unwilling flesh, bone and wood, but that it is the very redemption of our own world of betrayals, denials and crucifixions that is being constantly accomplished in Christ.

Again, the narrative that leads from Palm Sunday to Good Friday, a narrative that embraces wild, misplaced enthusiasms, fractured loyalties and agony and death, is what Jesus knew and felt. He experienced the whole range of emotions that we feel: triumph, hope, doubt, rejection, even betrayal; and yet it is through this experience that he brought himself closer to us. Jesus faces the worst that we can be and the worst that can happen to us. Ours is a faith that does not direct us first to a book, or to a feeling; rather we are directed to encounter the one thing we have the best chance of recognising -- a human being like ourselves. Through this Easter Week we are being reminded that hope looks like this, faith looks like this, God looks like this. Hence, we are being invited to come and experience (1) the beauty of the Last Supper-- the washing of the feet and the breaking and sharing of the Body of Christ with each other, as Jesus did with his disciples, in order to be a bread broken in humble service; (2) the brutality of Good Friday – the man who stood for “truth,” inviting all his anointed to stand guard against the powers of evil relentlessly, to stand upright in truth and commitment to goodness, in order to keep the world awake to God; and (3) finally the redemptive joy of the Easter Sunday – to an experience of new life and grace in the midst of death and brokenness.

A Grace-filled Easter Triduum!

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DIRECTIVES AND DECISIONS OF THE GENERAL CHAPTER 2025

As we are well aware, the General Chapter 2025, that was conducted in Visakhapatnam from 1st-14th of February 2025 and for which the entire congregation had prepared itself through prayers, reflections and studied proposals, has worked out a roadmap for our life and mission for the coming years in terms of various directives and decisions which were published already by our Superior General as the call of General Chapter 2025. Based on them our Superior General has singled out what he has called our “Ten-fold Commitments.” They are:

- 1) Commitment to Prayer, Intimate Relationship with the Lord, Personal Sanctity
- 2) Life of Self-Discipline and Simplicity of life
- 3) Community Life as Non-negotiable
- 4) Strengthening of Missionary Outreach and Renewal Programs
- 5) Re-defining the Initial Formation and Ongoing Formation
- 6) Education of the Heart as Integral to our Mission
- 7) Commitment to the Poor and Marginalized
- 8) Ensuring Financial Discipline at all levels
- 9) Appreciating and Fostering Our Heritage and Legacy
- 10) MSFS Growing and Working Together as One Global Family

He has also directed the provincials to work out concrete measures for their implementation. Accordingly, I propose the following steps for the personalization and implementation of the Spirit, the directives and the decisions of GC 2025 in our province.

Step 1: At the individual level each member of our province will use the text of the Call of the General Chapter 2025 for personal reading, reflection and personalization for the next six months.

Step2: The local superior will set apart sufficient time during the monthly community meetings to read and discuss specific sections from the Call of the GC 2025 so as to complete the study within six months.

STEP 3: Animators of the apostolic communities will call an extraordinary meeting specifically to study and imbibe the spirit of the “Call of the GC 2025.” One of the delegates

of the GC could be invited to this meeting as a resource person to impart the greater underlying spirit behind these directives and decisions.

Step 4: The local Superiors and Animators of all the apostolic communities will present to the provincial a report of the same not later than August 15, 2025.

Step 5: The Provincial presents a report of the progress of the follow-up measures taken to the General Administration by August 31, 2025.

My dear confreres, what is presented to us as the outcome of the General Chapter is nothing but God's concrete voice to all of us "that calls us to a more profound commitment, service, and faithfulness to our Charism." Therefore, let us be equally serious about our response.

Still struggling with the pain of the sudden demise of our beloved young confrere, Fr. Siby Manickathan, on behalf of the entire Province community, I want to thank all those who helped and stood by us throughout the painful moments. Besides sending a consoling message to all of us, Our Superior General travelled all the way to Germany right after landing in Rome to be present for the Requiem that was held in the Loizenkirchen parish church where Fr. Siby was serving. I want to thank Fr. Jimmy Parayankuzhy, who took upon himself as his own personal responsibility, right from the time he got the sad news, to make all the arrangements there, from taking care of all the legal matters, obtaining the necessary permissions, arranging the requiem and the customary meal thereafter, sorting out, recording and taking care of the personal belongings of Fr. Siby, till accompanying his mortal remains to India. He was admirably assisted by Fr. Joy Vazhappillil, our delegation superior, Fr. Sinto Manackaparambil of Vizag Province, the Vice-President of our society, Fr. James Panickerveetil and several others. My dear Confreres, in this moment of utter pain and loss, you have proved your

rootedness in the true Fransalian Spirit. All the arrangements at Fr. Siby's home and home parish was under the guidance of Fr. Shajan Manickathan and Fr. Siby's younger brother Mr. Sabu. While offering them once again our sincere condolences, I thank both of them sincerely. Right from receiving the body at the airport to the last details of the funeral services, everything was meticulously planned out and carried out by our Confreres of SFS Seminary under the admirable leadership of Fr. Jose Parappillil and the executive hands of Fr. Sijo Kovilparambil. No words can adequately thank the service they do for the province time and again, cheerfully and with utmost care for all the details. On behalf of all of us, I thank his excellency, Rt. Rev. Dr. Sebastian Thekethecheril, the Bishop of Vijayapuram, for presiding over the funeral services and Rev. Msgr. Sebastian Poovathumkal, for joining the services. 


